

## **6.3e STAR themed Treasure Hunt**

Follow this step-by-step guide to run the perfect STAR Treasure Hunt!

- ★ Participants get in teams of 3-4. You decide whether they have to pay to enter, get sponsored or collect money on route. Give students an incentive to get involved by providing a prize for the team that completes the list the fastest and gets the best photo!
- ★ Create a list of around 20 tasks that participants have to do and objects they have to collect in your local town, with photos being uploaded to your Facebook page as evidence of them being completed! The list has to be top secret until just before the start!
- ★ Add a time limit to the hunt but allow the best part of a day so that teams get a chance to complete the list and have fun whilst they are doing it.
- ★ Try and make a pub, a café or your SU the finish line and end with a party or social.
- ★ After the event ask people to send you the pictures for your Facebook page, website and fresher's fair next year.

*Example:*

You must collect:

1. One pack of 'magic stars'
2. Take a picture of the STAR logo in a phone box
3. Take away menu with cheapest egg fried rice you can find
4. A 1p coin from 1991
5. A picture of twins
6. One Star Fruit
7. A picture of the whole team with a bus driver
8. A picture of team outside Sherlock Homes House. 221B Baker Street, London NW1 6XE, London NW1 6XE (*Famous landmark in your town*)
9. A picture of the whole team drinking one red drink with individual straws.
10. Picture of the biggest Star you can find
11. Paint a part of one team member blue
12. Blag a free lunch! (It is for charity and lots of local restaurants would appreciate the advertising)
13. A receipt for 38p
14. A shot glass
15. Get 20 people to sign a petition (*You could use a campaign from the STAR website*)
16. A Bagel from Brick lane (*Change for outside of London*)
17. An S Club 7 CD (*extra point for a tape*)
18. A picture of the Queen (*A stamp or a coin*)
19. 10 people to put some coins in a collection tin
20. A bag of leaves (*A tea bag would do*)
